REGULATION



- The tournament will have 9 rounds for Open A and 7 Rounds for Open B and C
- Game time 90 minutes + 30 seconds bonus Fisher from first move.
- All Italian players must be registered with FSI 2024 are eligible; it is possible to register at the tournament venue.
- Foreign players must be in possession of the FIN (FIDE Identity Number).
- Any electronic device is Forbidden in the Tournament area, including but not limiting to mobile, laptops, pens, watches and so on .
- Smoking is prohibited (including electronic cigarettes); smokers will be able to frequent the dedicated outdoor area.
- It is possible to request, via email, to the Referee before the start of the tournament, only once (excluding the last 2 rounds) of the "half point lump sum".
- Players not physically present during the accreditation time will enter the second round.
- The player who arrives at the chessboard more than 60 minutes late than the starting time will lose the game.
- Pairing system: Swiss-Dutch. Tie-breaks in order: Buchholz integral, Buchholz cut1, A.R.O.
- For anything not covered in this regulation, the rules of the FSI and FIDE in force on the date of the event apply.
- Registration for the tournament entails acceptance of previous mentioned FSI and FIDE rules, and in particular: legal health prevention procedures, "anti-cheating" control rules, consent to the publication of one's data and images, results relating to the tournament, match schedules, media channels of the association.
- Disabled players, with particular logistical needs, are invited to notify their presence in advance.
- The organization offers up to 3 Wild Cards for Tournament A, to guarantee access to the higher tournament. Any interested player should communicate the interest to the organizer via email. The organization will decide the Wild Card for players close to the threshold rating or for particular sporting merits.
- The organization reserves the right to make any changes that may be necessary for the success of the event.

BYES (Half point bye)

- If you are unable to play a round, you may request a half point bye (HPB), in advance.
- Each player can request the HPB only once for the tournament.
- HPB should be requested and communicated in written form at least two hours before the start of the first round of the tournament, indicating exactly for which round the player ask the HPB
- The HPB cannot be asked for one of the last two rounds of the Tournament.
- Once communicated , the HPB request can not be revoked

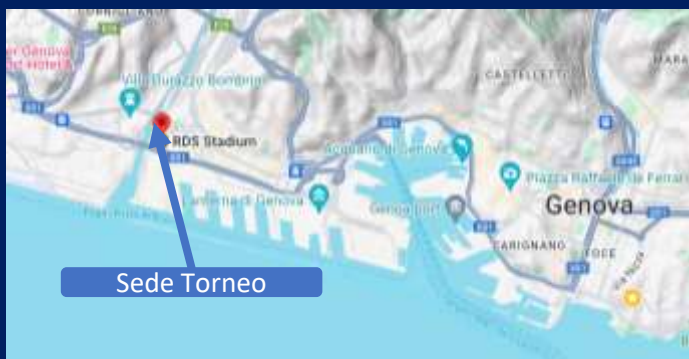


STADIUM GENOVA (RDS) Pala Fiumara Genova

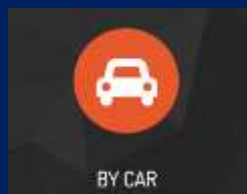


You can reach the Fiumara directly from the Sampierdarena train station. From platform 6, you can go directly to Fiumara Center.

How to get to Genova



Getting to Genoa is really easy: the city airport Cristoforo Colombo is located in Sestri Ponente and it is connected to the city down town by bus. The maritime stations connect Genoa to the main ports of the Mediterranean Sea. The railway lines are the most comfortable and effective way not only to reach the Ligurian city, but also to move around it: in fact, its railway branches cross the Genoese territory from West to the East. There are also four highways that allow you to reach Genoa by car: A12, A10, A26 and A7.

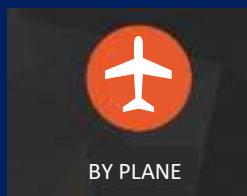


Four highways connect the city to the national network from various points:

- A12 Genova - Rosignano: for those coming from the East, exits GE Nervi and GE Est;
- A10 dei Fiori Genova - Ventimiglia: for those coming from the West, exits GE Prà, GE Pegli, and GE Aeroporto;
- A26 Voltri - Gravellona Toce: reconnects to A10 at the GE Prà junction, to move towards the North;
- A7 Serravalle Genova - Milano: exits GE Bolzaneto, Genova Ovest, to move towards the North.



Genova has a railway network that stretches along the east-west axes and internal routes connecting it to Northern Europe. The main railway stations are Genova Principe (a preferred starting point for travel to the west and north) and Genova Brignole (the main departure point for connections to the east and south). The train is certainly one of the most convenient means of transportation, even within the city, along the line connecting neighborhoods along the coast from Voltri to Nervi. Regulation

- The Tournament will be held according to FIDE tournament Rules and Laws of Chess.
- The FIDE Anti-Cheating rules and guidelines are valid.
- The games are played using the electronic clocks and boards approved by FIDE.
- The event will consist in 9 rounds
- The time control will be 3 minutes + 2 seconds increment per move, starting from move 1.
- The final ranking order of the players is determined by the number of points scored.
- In case of a tie, the next tie-break criteria are established:
 - Buchholz cut 1
 - Buchholz
 - the greater number of games with black (not played games count as played with white)
 - the greater number of wins
